

## **Texas Maritime Museum Executive Director Opportunity (1/1/2024)**

The Texas Maritime Museum (TMM) seeks a highly qualified individual to serve as the Museum's permanent Executive Director to manage and oversee the administration and operations of the Museum programs, staff, and facilities. This is a full-time salaried position at the Museum's offices in Rockport, TX. The Director works in close partnership with the Museum's Board of Trustees, volunteers, and supporters to carry out the TMM's mission, programs, and operational strategies and to ensure the safety, security, and well-being of the facilities and persons involved with TMM operations. The Director represents the TMM in the community and dealings with stakeholders, local and state agencies, local and regional community organizations, businesses, sponsors, and donors.

Critical qualifications for the position include:

1. Knowledge of Texas ports, waterways, and past and current maritime activities.
2. Demonstrated skills and experience with program management.
3. Strong interpersonal, speaking, and writing skills.
4. Knowledge of and experience with non-profit corporations or organizations.
5. Experience with grant programs, including grant applications and administration.
6. Working knowledge of the agencies and organizations with roles related to the TMM's missions and programs, such as the Texas Historical Commission, U.S. Navy, U.S. Army Corps of Engineers, and U.S. Coast Guard.

Additional desirable qualifications include:

1. Experience with museum operations and management.
2. Commercial or military maritime industry experience.
3. Experience with maritime operations in Texas.
4. Established communications networks with port and commercial maritime professionals in Texas and elsewhere.
5. Knowledge of commercial and military vessel design and construction practices.
6. Experience with historic vessels.
7. Experience with historic and maritime sites in Texas.
8. Facility management experience, including safety and security requirements and practices.

The anticipated start date is July 1, 2024; other proposed dates will be considered.
